### **Call for Abstracts**

The UF Institute on Aging is currently soliciting abstract submissions for our 7<sup>th</sup> annual research day. This call is targeted to researchers across all colleges at UF and the VA in order to bring together the aging research community to share current findings and foster collaboration. This year the focus of the event is “Inflammation and Aging”. A \$250 award will be given to the best clinical and preclinical student research poster in this focus. Undergraduate, graduate, medical and postdoctoral students are eligible for the awards.

### **Online Abstract Submission**

Abstract submissions will be accepted through our online submission process at our website (<http://aging.ufl.edu/2016/07/07/7th-annual-spotlight-on-inflammation-and-aging-research/>) through August 12, 2016. The abstract text should not exceed 350 words. Do not include figures, tables or mathematical equations in the abstract. Avoid acronyms. Spell out abbreviations the first time you use them. If you use references, provide the journal, volume, year, and page numbers; however, references count as words toward your abstract, and are not required. Presentation of specific data and methodological details, clarity and brevity of writing and a clear statement regarding conclusions will assist in judging the quality of the research.
